TO REGISTER FOR A SECOND MAJOR IN ADDITION TO YOUR FIRST MAJOR, YOU MUST SHOW BOTH MAJORS ON THE SAME FORM. OTHERWISE THE NEW MAJOR WILL REPLACE YOUR FIRST MAJOR, RATHER THAN BEING ADDED AS A SECOND MAJOR.

All Education students, including transfer students, enrolling in their 36th university credit hour are required to declare their stream, degree major, teachable major, and teachable minor through the Faculty of Education. Faculty of Education "Declaration of Stream, Major and Minor" forms are provided to Education students as part of their Year 2 Registration Kit and should be submitted to the Faculty of Education by July 31."
