

NEW: IDS practicum opportunity in Thailand

Spring 2017 (May 1 to July 30) and Fall (September 1 to November 30)

Deadline for spring session February 15, 2017

Deadline for fall session May 15, 2017

Global EDventure Volunteer Teaching Program and Community Development, Lertlah School

This unique opportunity will provide IDS students with an experience that incorporates English-language teaching in Bangkok with assisting community development programs in villages outside of Bangkok.

The *spring session* (May 1 to July 30, 2017) will include four days a week of English teaching in Bangkok and one day a week of work with women's support organizations in rural villages.

The *fall session* (September 1 to November 30, 2017) will include two months of English teaching in Bangkok (September and November) and one month of living in a rural village homestay and volunteering with a women's community development organization.

Lertlah University provides a program coordinator on the ground in Thailand who is fluent in English and provides support to the student volunteers. *English as Additional Language* training is not a requirement and training will be provided.

Costs to student:

- Return flights, Visa costs, vaccinations
- \$300 administration fee which pays for all administration costs, predeparture orientation and Canada/Thailand support

Costs covered by Global Edventure:

- Airport pickup and orientation in Bangkok
- All housing and meals
- All ground transportation during the three month period
