Practicum Placement Opportunity at the NorWest Youth Hub

The NorWest Youth Hub is an integrated service centre for youth between the ages 12-29, offering free services in the areas of mental health, substance use, primary healthcare, employment, recreation, and more. Youth Hubs provide low-barrier, youth-friendly, integrated services for young people and their families in a “one-stop-shop” model.

Responsibilities May Include:

- Welcoming visitors to the Youth Hub and conducting COVID-19 screening
- Assisting with facilitation of the youth drop-in program
- Planning and facilitation of recreational and mental health-focused programming using an anti-oppressive, harm reduction framework, including programming for youth experiencing marginalization (2SLGBTQIA+, BIPOC, and low-income youth)
- Assisting with the development of content for social media platforms
- Representing the Youth Hub through outreach programming- i.e., resource fairs, school and community presentations, etc.
- Participation in, and coordination of, the volunteer tutoring program

We are able to accommodate both virtual and in-person placements (dependent on provincial health restrictions).
